The program is for Teaneck children age 3 and up.

To participate:

-Register online at TeaneckLibrary.Beanstack.org

Caregivers should create an account for themselves first and then register their children under that account.

-Check out and read Teaneck Public Library books, magazines and audiobooks at your level. Log one book a week to be entered into a raffle to win a free book. Books must be checked out from Teaneck Public Library in order to qualify.

-After completing each book, record the title online at TeaneckLibrary.Beanstack.org. Picture Books and Early Readers should be counted as 30 pages per book. For graphic novels record 1/2 the number of pages on your reading log. For example, a 240 page book would be recorded as 120 pages on your log.

-Win fun prizes as you move through the levels.
