Pre-registration begins **Monday, June 11th** (prizes can be earned 6/20 at the earliest). Last day to record books and receive prizes is Monday, August 20th.

To participate:

- Register online at TeaneckLibrary.Beanstack.org
- Borrow and read Teaneck Public Library books, audio books or magazines. Books must be checked out from and belong to the Teaneck Public Library.
- Record the number of pages read in your online reading log.
- You can read or listen to an audio book.
- You can read graphic novels but only half the number of pages count for your log. For example, a 200 page graphic novel would be recorded as 100 pages on your reading log.

Win prizes as you move up through the levels.

- Level 1 (350 pages)
- Level 2 (700 pages)
- Level 3 (1400 pages)
- Level 4 (2800 pages)
- Level 5 (5600 pages)
